Step into the past on this private, guided walk through Los Peñasquitos Canyon, where ancient springs, settler ruins, and shaded oak groves tell stories of 7,000 years of human history.





Led by expert naturalist Cypress Hansen, you'll visit a centuries-old homestead, a mysterious grave site, and one of the county's oldest buildings—all tucked within a peaceful, river canyon full of wildlife.
