This walk takes place at Torrey Pines State Reserve, a beautiful park full of native wildlife just ~30 minutes from Downtown San Diego.

Using your preferred maps app, navigate to the Torrey Pines Visitor Center, 12600 N Torrey Pines Rd, La Jolla, CA 92037. (Pictured above) The nearby trail will take us through all the beautiful habitats Torrey Pines has to offer.

Look for Cypress at the trailhead — she will have a teal-colored vest on.
