Using your preferred maps app, navigate to 982 Stonebridge Trail in Solana Beach. (Pictured above) This trail will take us through all of the beautiful habitats San Elijo lagoon has to offer.

Look for Cypress at the trailhead — she will have a teal-colored vest on.
